## Take Away Points

- 6 \& 8 must be strong and versatile
- Increased responsibility of 10
- Attacking players eliminate opposing resets
- ZONE 14 must be shut down


## 6-8

$6 \& 8$ serve as screening players, sandwiching opposing offensive players in front of $4 \& 5$ preventing passes to the forwards.

ZONE 14!

- Area right in front of the $18 y d$ box
- ~70\% of goals originate here
- 6\&8 MUST plug holes 10

As the "third" center defensive player, 10 would be giving up outside pockets of space....again adding protection to ZONE 14. At this point, 11 \& 7 could (and should) drop back to make formation SEEM like (4-4-1-1), thus double teaming opposing wide players.

10 can also neutralize opponent's deep play maker

## 11,10,7,9

These offensive players are also to apply immediate pressure when opposing team tries to play the ball back

## 10,8,6

Could (and should) also stagger with 6 taking on a slightly more defensive responsibilities freeing up 8 to be more of a play maker. Regardless, both holding defensive midfielders are to (each) distribute effectively
