LUMINARIES & LANTERNS

It's not so much to merely light a room up, but to do so creatively. The piercings will create great patterns that lightbulbs cannot. Put that consideration when you make your canopy.

NON-OBJECTIVE DESIGN

Nonobjective art is another way to refer to Abstract art or nonrepresentational art. Essentially, the artwork does not represent or depict a person, place or thing in the natural world. Usually, the content of the work is its color, shapes, size, or scale.....so no Batman symbols!!

K.I.S.S(TUDENTS)

The idea behind keeping your sculpture and design simple is three-fold. First of all light can only bend so much and if you create more obstacles for light to work around, the fainter the light will be. Second, don't underestimate the power of simplicity. The design will be easier to carve, but the effect will still be great. Thirdly, think of Las Vegas. The city is not much to look at during the day, but at night the city looks amazing



LIGHTED SCULPTURE

For this assignment, you will be creating a luminary measuring approximately 6"w x 12"h x 6"d. you will need a base for which to place a candle and a perforated canopy that will allow light to escape from it.

Lighted sculptures, like luminaries and lanterns, not only lights up a room but uses light to make a visual extension of the free standing sculpture.
